CREDIT EQUIVALENCY FOR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM

To Whom It May Concern

Here is the general guideline for the credit equivalency (SKS is the Indonesian credit system) for undergraduate students by region or country:

1. For universities in Shoutheast Asia, Japan and China (Mainland), 1 credit = 1 SKS. In these universities, similar to IPB University, students can take up to around 20 total credits per semester.
2. For universities in Europe, 1 ECTS = 2/3 (or 0.67) SKS (1.5 ECTS = 1 SKS). In these universities, students usually can take up to around 30 total credits (30 ECTS) per semester.
3. For universities in South Korea, 1 Korean credit equals 5/3 (or 1.67) ECTS (3 Korean credits equal 5 ECTS). That is, 1 SKS = 9/10 (or 0.9) Korean credit. Typically, a maximum number of Korean credits students can take is 19 credits (or around 21 SKS) per semester.
4. For universities in the USA, Taiwan, and Hong Kong, 1 credit usually equals 2 ECTS. That is, 1 SKS = $\frac{3}{4}$ (or 0.75) US / Taiwanese credit.
